

HAPPENING ON ICE FSAQ 2010

EVENT PRESENTED IN ST-ARMAND (PHILIPSBURG) QC.
FEBRUARY 20th, 2010

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

This event is organized in conformity with the Fédération de Sport Automobile du Québec ice racing regulations. These regulations may be amended by the instructions of the Clerk of the course.

Please refer to our web site (www.fsaq.qc.ca) on Thursday the 18th of February to confirm the event (weather condition changes) is not cancelled.

SITE :

The track is located on Lake Champlain in St-Armand, QC. (Philipsburg), directions below:

When arriving via highway 20 from Québec:

- 1) Take exit 98 towards highway 30 West.
- 2) Continue on highway 30 West to exit 109 towards highway 10 East.
- 3) On highway 10 east, take exit 22 for highway 35 south towards Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu;
- 4) Stay on highway 35 South to the end. The end of 35 flows onto route 133: continue on 133 to St-Armand where there is a yellow flasher. Turn right on Montgomery st.
- 5) On Montgomery go to third street on right : Champlain avenue to the :Restaurant Le 8^e Ciel, just after turning. Registration will be at the restaurant.
- 6) The lake is adjacent to the restaurant, the entry to the site is a bit further along the lake. Follow the signs.

When arriving on highway 20 from Montreal:

- 1) Take exit 98 towards highway 30 West.
- 2) Continue on highway 30 West to exit 109 towards highway 10 East.
- 3) On highway 10 East, take exit 22 for highway 35 South towards Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu;
- 4) Stay on highway 35 South to the end. The end of 35 flows onto route 133 : continue on 133 to St-Armand where there is a yellow flasher. Turn right on Montgomery street.
- 5) On Montgomery go to third street on right : Champlain avenue to the : Restaurant Le 8^e Ciel just after turning. Registration will be at the restaurant.
- 6) The lake is adjacent to the restaurant, the entry to the site is a bit further along the lake. Follow the signs.

From Montreal by Champlain bridge:

1. From Champlain Bridge, continue on highway 10 East to exit 22 towards (Route 35_Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu) ;
Stay on highway 35 South to the end. The end of 35 flows onto route 133: continue on 133 to St-Armand where there is a yellow flasher. Turn right on Montgomery street.
- 2) On Montgomery go to third street on right: Champlain avenue to the Restaurant Le 8^e Ciel just after turning. Registration will be at the restaurant.
- 3) The lake is adjacent to the restaurant; the entry to the site is a bit further along the lake. Follow the signs.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be held at the Restaurant Le 8e Ciel at 193, avenue Champlain near the lake and track from 7.00 to 9.00 am. All participants (Drivers & crew) must register in person.

VEHICLE CLASSES

Cars will grouped the following way : Studs two (2) wheel traction, Studs four (4) wheel traction and Rubber (no studs).

The starting order for the first qualifying will be determined by practice times.

Qualifying are races.

REGISTRATION COST

The cost of registration is 112.88\$ tax included, payable in cash or by check to : Fédération de Sport Automobile du Québec or FSAQ or Paypal at www.paypal.com à info@fsaq.qc.ca. If an invitation race is held the cost will be 25.00\$. Registration includes passes for driver and (4) crews. Additional crew member registration is 5.00\$.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Technical inspection shall be performed in the paddock.

TRACK

The track measures 1.8 km, the race will be of counter clock direction.

START

All starts will be STANDING starts.

WINNERS

Winners will be presented at the end of the day at the Restaurant Le 8e Ciel.
